TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

These terms and conditions apply to all contestants entering the Drag Rumble Pageant in South Yorkshire, England and are designed to ensure fairness, safety, and respect for all participants and organisers.

Eligibility

- Entrants must be aged 16 years or older on the date of the competition (or meet the minimum age stipulated by the pageant).
- Contestants aged 17 years or under will require permission from their parent and/or guardian to participate.
- Entrants may be required to provide valid proof of age and identity (e.g., passport or official ID) upon request.
- Entrants must reside within a Yorkshire and The Humber postal code area (BD, DL, DN, HD, HG, HU, HX, LA, LS, S, WF or YO)
- All contestants should have personal conduct consistent with the ethos of the pageant; organisers may refuse entry if a background check reveals conduct likely to bring the event into disrepute.

Entry and Fees

- Entry to the pageant is voluntary and no performance fee or payment is made for appearance, travel or accommodation by the Drag Rumble pageant.
- All applications must be submitted via the official entry form and received by the published deadline.
- Entry fees of £100.00 must be paid in full before the application is accepted.
- Entry fees are non-refundable and non-transferable, even if the contestant withdraws or does not compete on the day.

Code of Conduct

- Contestants must behave professionally, respectfully, and inclusively toward judges, staff, other contestants, and the audience.
- Harassment, discrimination, hate speech, or abusive behaviour of any kind will not be tolerated and may lead to disqualification.
- Contestants must not publicly defame or misrepresent the pageant, organisers, sponsors, or fellow performers.

Attendance and Participation

- Contestants may be required to attend rehearsals, interviews, and official events related to the pageant.
- Contestants must be available for all dates relating to the event. These will be provided within official booking confirmation.
- Winners and finalists are expected to fulfil promotional responsibilities (media appearances, community engagements, etc.) during their title year.

Media Release

- By entering, contestants grant permission for their image, name, performance footage, and photography to be used by the pageant organisers and partners for promotional purposes without compensation.
- Contestants waive rights to royalties or payment for such media use.
- If selected to take part, contestants are not permitted to disclose their participation until an official media release by the pageant organisers. Contestants may be disqualified if found to be releasing such information.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Safety and Liability

- Contestants accept that organisers are not responsible for injury, loss, or damage incurred during the competition or related events.
- Performers must follow safety directives from venue staff and organisers at all times.
- Any props, costume elements, or performance elements that pose safety hazards must be approved in advance.

Disqualification

- Organisers reserve the right to disqualify contestants who breach these terms, including misconduct before or during the event.
- Winners who fail to fulfil their obligations may be required to relinquish titles, crowns, prizes, or awards.

Rule Changes

- Pageant organisers reserve the right to modify event formats, rules, or schedules if necessary in the interests of safety, fairness, or practicality.

Winning Prize

- The winning contestant will receive a crown and sceptre. It is the responsibility of the reigning contestant until the following year's pageant. Both crown and scepter must be returned 4 weeks before the following pageant.
